As a founder of and contributor to interfaith organizations she is a passionate advocate for social justice issues and is a frequent contributor to newspapers and public forums. She is a member of the Unitarian Universalist Christian Fellowship. Rev. Onnie retired to Staunton, Virginia in January 2021, where she continues to supply local pulpits and, via Zoom, pulpits nationwide. She recently served as a sabbatical minister for a congregation in Canada. She also revived her pre-ministerial career as a professional musician, serving as volunteer coordinator for the Staunton Music Festival and playing with the Flutes of the Shenandoah.
